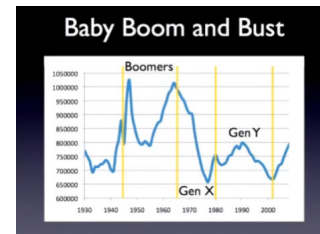


Assembly line

Charities



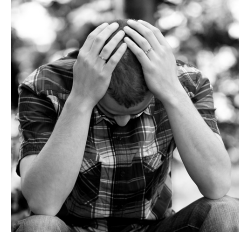
donations of meals to hungry people

Debt

Depression



a period of unemployment and hardship

Division of Labor

Dust Bowl

Many African Americans came together to share their ideas and their art

Hydroelectricity



Dams along the Tennessee River and prevented flooding

Mass Production



what Henry Ford used to build cars cheaply

Minimum wage



the lowest amount of money a worker can be paid

New Deal



a variety of government programs started by Franklin D. Roosevelt

Prohibition



Lasted from 1917 to 1933. It was illegal to drink or sell alcohol during this time

Stock



a piece of ownership in a company

Stock market



people buy and sell shares of a company's stock

Unemployment
